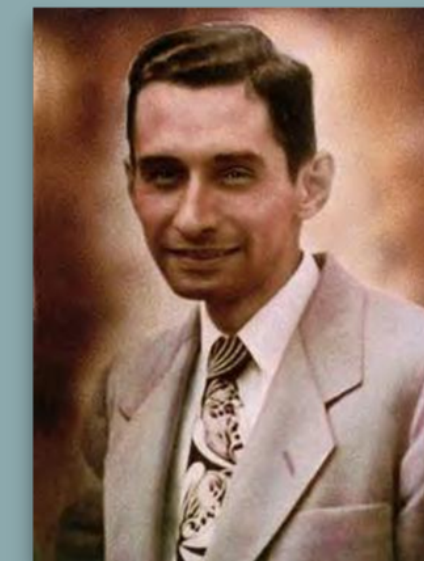
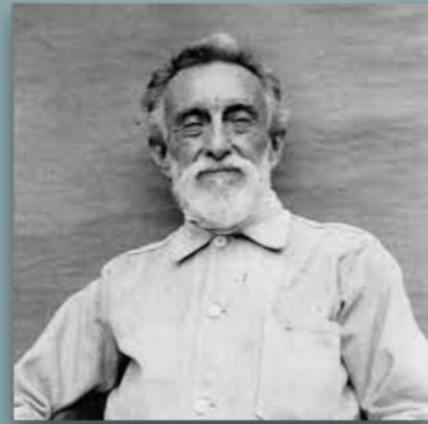


# AMERICAN SAINTS IN THE PIPELINE

## Roman stage

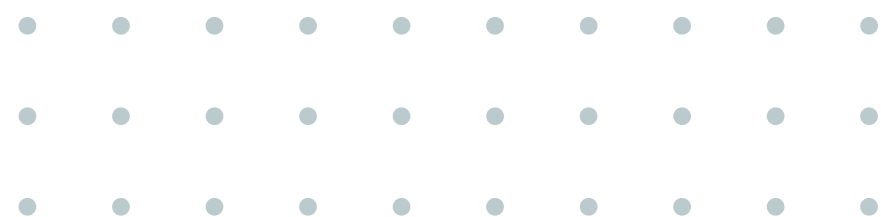

*1 miracle after candidate's death. Limited public veneration*

## Blessed -----> Saint

*1 miracle after beatification, including for martyrs*
